- Prevention of Accidents, Safety Concerns and Working of Safety Committees and other agencies.
- Dos’ & Donts’ in case of Accidents.
- Fire Hazards and Fire Safety Measures.
- Safety, Health and Welfare of workforce.
- Management of Disaster.
- Inspection by Labour Department and other Govt. Agencies.
- Penal Provisions and Protection of Occupier / Manager / Contractor against likely prosecutions.
